"D4", GHOSTWATER FILMS' SCI-FI ACTION ADVENTURE FILM, NOW COMPLETE.

Ghostwater Films recently held the Cast and Crew Premiere of its Sci-fi Action Adventure film "D4" at the Carmike Highland 12 in Cookeville, TN. Cookeville was chosen for the first screening based on the fact that 90% of the film was shot in nearby Alpine and Livingston. Additional days were shot in Spring Hill, Cool Springs and Columbia.

D4 follows a team of ex-military mercenaries who have been hired by a rich eccentric doctor to rescue her kidnapped son, whom she believes is being held in an abandoned government facility known as the D4. The mercenaries see it as easy money, but, as things unfold, the team discovers there's more to it. What started out as a simple search and rescue has turned into a fight for survival.

The script and motivation to do the film came from the Director's son being diagnosed with a benign epilepsy in May of 2007 and their experiences with the medications he was given. Dickerson says, "I took our experiences with my son, our conversations, the office visits, the stress and confusion of our real life experience, then pushed it through the dark parts of my brain and twisted it into a sci-fi action thriller. It stands on it's own as a movie, but if you know the real story, it all hits pretty close to real life in some form or fashion. Most of the script was motivated in some way by my boy's experience."

The core cast was asked to dedicate some of their time ahead of the shoot to training. In addition to readings together, the Special Op.s cast spent time firing live weapons and learning proper team movements and techniques. They were instructed by a weapons expert from Columbia, TN, a special weapons instructor from the TN State Troopers and a member of the Franklin S.W.A.T. team. "We were put through the paces of how to take a house, clear rooms, just simply how to walk correctly. Not only did it lend us a credible look in the film, it gave us all a great appreciation for what these guys do."

The first leg of the shoot consisted of eight straight days in the mountains in East Tennessee, during rains and temperatures in the 30's and 40's. The next three legs were shorter, but no less strenuous. One leg consisted of four days in a condemned building.

Ghostwater Films personally took on the bulk of the post production, from the edit to the Visual FX to the final audio mix. Dickerson says, "This was almost a total in-house production, with the exception of the musical score and a portion of the sound design, everything from start to finish was done in-house at Ghostwater. There are creatures in the movie, and we did the sound design for them as well...something I'm very proud of...I think it came out great."

Receiving requests from distributors before the film was complete, Ghostwater has begun the process of issuing preview copies. The hope is to team with the distributor who can offer the most exposure and then move on to the next project. Ghostwater has two scripts in development behind D4, another Sci-fi Action Adventure and a Thriller.

D4 was Written and Directed by Darrin Dickerson. Produced by David B. Stevens. Co-produced by Scott McDaniel and Tina Dickerson. Original music was composed by Nathan Whitehead. D4's lead cast consists of Jaimee Gray Simon, Darrin Dickerson, Jeff Hime, Clay Brocker, Eric Berner, Big Mike Ulm, Vicki Askew and Ted Lagarde.

In addition to narrative film projects, Ghostwater does music videos, commercial and corporate work. Ghostwater Films, Inc. is owned by Director/Producer Darrin Dickerson. Some of Dickerson's past projects include John Michael Montgomery's Letters From Home, Randy Travis' Angels, Tresa Jordan's Angels Cry and a number of award winning short films and television commercials.
